

Do's and Don't's Of Scout Outings

DO'S:

*Scouts and ASMs should be in their full Class A uniforms Friday night as we depart Living Word Church and Sunday morning as we return from the outing.

*Please make sure that your Scout has a **confirmed** ride both to and from the outing before we depart for the outing.

*Once at the outing, your Scout is expected to stay for the entire scheduled time. We would prefer that the adults stay as well, if possible.

*If your Scout must leave the outing early or arrive to the outing late, please notify the SPL (Ben Lawrence), the Scoutmaster (Kelly Miller) and the Outing Coordinator. You must notify these 3 individuals before the outing and at the time that you are leaving/arriving with your Scout.

*The Boy Scout policy states that Scouts tent with Scouts and adults tent with adults--NO EXCEPTIONS.

*Any adult attending an outing must bring his/her own tent, sleeping bag, sleeping pad, mess kit, water bottle, folding chair, etc. You may make arrangements to tent with another adult.

*The troop will provide your meals as a registered and paid participant of the outing.

DON'T'S

*The Scouts are not allowed to bring "pressurized" lighters (Bic, etc) to the outing. It is okay for Scouts to bring Zippo lighters.

*Scouts should not bring any spare Zippo fluid. Please have your Scouts fill up their lighters before coming to the outing.

*Scouts are not allowed to bring any electronics to any outings and this includes cell phones. Most adults carry cell phones with them and will be more than willing to allow the Scouts to use them if necessary. It is okay for Scouts to bring cameras on an outing.
